### **ALL RESIDENTS: NEW IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE FM-eCAP PROJECT**

The Family Medicine electronic Curriculum and Assessment Platform (FM-eCAP) project was created to move curriculum, assessment and evaluation to an electronic platform in the core 2-year FM Residency Program and also each of the FM Enhanced Skills Programs. The solution chosen is Elentra, created by Queens University as part of the consortium in which the University of Calgary is also an active participant.

The combined Department of Family Medicine & Cumming School of Medicine IT project team has been working since June 2019 to review curriculum & assessment requirements for each of our Programs as well as the functionality available within Elentra. This approach has so far allowed the team to understand the academic, technical and business requirements that go along with such a major project and has helped us prepare and begin planning for this change.

We estimate we will have the platform implemented in July 2020, followed by further enhancements aimed at continually improving the user experience. We are reaching out to you given your ongoing involvement with the Family Medicine Residency Program. We will provide monthly updates to create awareness and encourage the planned users of the system to provide feedback on an ongoing basis. In addition, as this development progresses, we will work closely with our various user-groups (Preceptors, Departmental and Program Leaders, Residents, & Administrative staff) to ensure the solutions implemented meets the needs of each of our Programs.

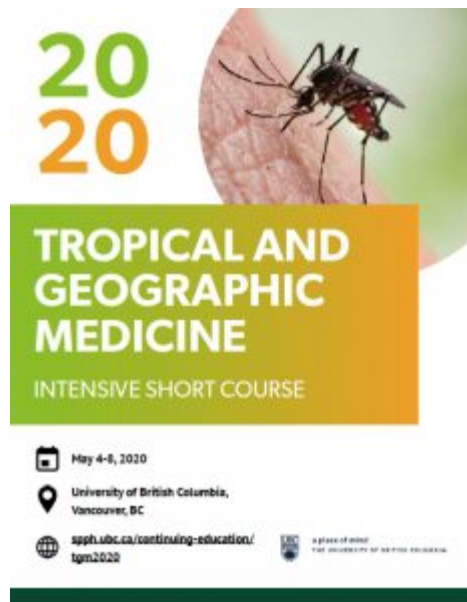
