## ALL RESIDENTS: **NEW** MCCQE PART II AND COROAVIRUS DISEASE (COVID 19)

*The Medical Council of Canada (MCC) is carefully monitoring the rapidly changing situation with the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) and is developing contingency plans for various scenarios which may lead to service disruption.*

*With this in mind, we have reached out to the Federation of Medical Regulatory Authorities of Canada (FMRAC) and the Medical Regulatory Authorities, for reassurance that, should MCC's Qualifying Examination Part II scheduled for May 2 and 3, 2020 have to be cancelled in specific locations or nationally, and rescheduled to a later time, there will be no unnecessary delay in either providing provisional registration or extending educational licences for impacted candidates.*

*In this, we are advocating on behalf of learners across the country for as minimal a disruption as possible in their transition to practice.*

*I anticipate hearing from FMRAC shortly and will communicate further as the situation evolves.*

*Of note, we were able to successfully complete the National Assessment Collaboration Examination for International Medical Graduates on Saturday, March 7 at seven locations around the country.*

**Reminder** - the deadline for accepting Resident RESEARCH Travel Grant applications for conferences scheduled from April 1 to June 30, 2020 is **March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020**. Once again, to address the concern that residents may not have received notification that their abstracts have been accepted for presentation, Travel Grant applications will be accepted without the confirmation.
